Dear Members,

Recent comments shared with members of the Board of Directors have indicated our increased effort to inform all UICC members regarding happenings at the Irish Center have been well received. In addition to sending bi-weekly e-mails regarding upcoming events and posting updates on our website (www.irishcentersf.org), we announced a plan to provide a UICC Bulletin to every member household during the year 2006 funded solely by donations and sponsorships rather than on a "subscription only" basis.

Mitzi Samson of the Communications Committee subsequently provided hard numbers at the December Membership Meeting indicating the cost is too dear and the plan too ambitious to proceed at this time. The Board of Directors thus determined only members who pay the \$20.00 subscription fee will continue to receive the bulletin (see enclosed subscription info). A free copy of the bulletin will be sent via e-mail to any member who contacts our webmaster by email at info@irishcentersf.org. Please be kind enough to pass this information along to those members who may not have received this message. This will be the last regular Bulletin sent without a paid subscription.

The Audit (tel ext. 303) and Finance (tel ext. 302) Committees have submitted through Treasurer Karen Kinahan (tel ext. 301) a letter recommending I3 changes to the current operations including immediately closing the Dining Room/Bar, actively focusing our operation solely on Banquets, limiting the days we are available for club meetings and convening a meeting of Past Presidents/Board Members to create a plan for the future. As many of you know, these recommendations are very similar to those presented in October 2004 which led to many of the changes we experienced over the past year. The Board of Directors has been reviewing these recommendations and will draw from the experience of the appropriate committees and past board members to determine which will be implemented. You will all be notified of any changes.

The remaining 32/50 Program money left from 2004 had been kept aside through November 2005 for use on specific items as recommended by that committee. It was recently used to offset some operations costs but the 2005 money remains in the appropriate account for distribution as per the regular process for that program. The Board of Directors expects this program to continue into 2006 and beyond, provided we have volunteers to staff it. Please call Bill Luqué (tel ext. 305) to volunteer your time.

The Presidents Appeal (tel ext. 104) balance remains above \$29,000. The total amount collected for 2005 was \$55,717.91. This money was spent on a new dishwasher, an awning, dishes, plate covers, projector repairs, notices in the church bulletins, carpet cleaning, plumbing repairs and HVAC Maintenance. As promised, none of this money has been nor will be used to pay salaries. We welcome your ongoing donations for this Fund.

One thing is clear, despite the best intentions and hard work of our dedicated volunteer Board and Committee Members, we have not significantly improved the operation of this business over the past year. We did not lose anything near amounts lost in the past (estimates for the year are -\$30,000), but we are unable to demonstrate how our current procedures and methods have brought us any closer to achieving solid financial footing.

Members have voiced opinions on why this may be...payment at the door, poor menu, inconsistent service, bad communication, an overall lack of accountability...One member of the Finance Committee characterized our efforts as "band aids" for a bigger problem. The Board agrees we need a 2006 Budget, a Procedures Manual, Food/Labor/Operations Cost Analysis, a Daily Report and consistent communication to and from all our members. We also need help making these things happen.

The Operations Committee (tel ext. 105), chaired by Vice President Joan McClain will continue to work on addressing issues pertinent to that committee. The Committee consists of Joan, John Donohue, Pat Maguire, Bill Luque and newly appointed Anne Carew. Your input is helpful, especially if you have food and beverage, plant operations or restaurant management experience. Please call Joan to offer your assistance.

This is not an impossible task...but as volunteers balancing family and work, these commitments can be very difficult. These past months have been especially hard on all of us.


