


32/50 CLUB

FREE FLU SHOTS

Michael Vaughan, MD (Doctor Mick) along with other wolunteers will be administering influenza immunizations to those in need in the Irish community, two hundred immunizations will be administered on a first come first serve basis two Sundays in October at the United Irish Cultural Center.

On Sunday, October 8, from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm (during brunch) flu shots will be given those at the highest risk. This includes children, senior citizens, caretakers of children and senior citizens, and pregnant women.

On Sunday, October 22 from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm remaining flu shots will be given to those who can least afford them, i.e. undocumented residents.

If you are a nurse or nurse's aid and would like to volunteer to help, please contact Doctor Mick at 415/412-1749.

Those at the highest risk are those who need the flu shot the most. They include:

- Children 6-23 months
- Adults age 60 and older
- Caregivers of the above groups (nannies, home health aids)
- Pregnant women
- People of all ages who have chronic medical conditions
- The disabled who have compromised respiratory function
