



The Easter Rising 1916 (Éirí Amach na Cásca)

Organized by the Irish Republican Brotherhood, the Easter Rising occurred April 24-30 when Irish Republicans such as Patrick Pearse and James Connolly, proclaiming Ireland an independent republic of Britain, commandeered several Dublin public buildings such as the General Post Office. Although the Rising was halted and its leaders were court-martialled and executed, it reignited Ireland's quest for freedom and self-rule. Episode at Easter by Sean MacEntee

The Irish Rebellion of 1916 or The Unbroken Tradition by Nora Connolly

History of the Sinn Féin Movement and the Irish Rebellion of 1916 by Francis P. Jones

Sinn Féin Rebellion Handbook, published by the Weekly Irish Times (in wall display case)

Rare Book

History of Ireland, Ancient and Modern, Taken from the Most Authentic Records and Dedicated to the Irish Brigade: with a Continuation from the Treaty of Limerick to the Present Time by Abbé MacGeoghegan and John Mitchel. Published in NewYork by D. & J. Sadlier & Co, 1868.

The first part, written by MacGeoghegan, covers Ireland's history to the Treaty of Limerick and Mitchel continues from that point. Born in Co. Derry the son of a Presbyterian minister, Mitchel became an Irish Patriot and founded the journal *United Irishmen*. This first edition can be viewed in the library wall display case.


