#### Happy Birthday, Daniel O'Connell, Liam O'Flaherty and Jack Butler Yeats

Born August 6 in Co. Kerry, lawyer **Daniel O'Connell** (1775-1847), called "The Liberator", studied Irish legal and political history in his youth. He crusaded for Catholic Emancipation, the right of Catholics to become a member of London's Parliament, which was achieved in 1829. In addition, he spoke at various rallies throughout Ireland to repeal the union between Ireland and Great Britain. One of them, attended by 750,000, took place on August 15, 1829, at Tara, Co. Meath (where Ireland's High Kings were once crowned). One of his famous quotes is: "The altar of liberty totters when it is cemented only with blood." O'Connell inspired 20th century American civil rights leader Martin Luther King and Indian independence leader Mahatma Gandhi. A portrait of O'Connell hangs in the library. Books in the library on O'Connell: King of the Beggars: Daniel O'Connell and the Rise of Irish Democracy (Sean O'Faolain); Daniel O'Connell: His Early Life and Journal, 1795 to 1802 (Arthur Houston, ed.); and Daniel O'Connell (Denis Gwynn).

Liam O'Flaherty (1896-1984), born August 28 on Inishmore, Aran Islands, was a novelist and short-story writer, considered a major figure in the Irish Renaissance. Born in poverty, O'Flaherty grew up speaking Irish, which his family discouraged, and later wrote some of his works in Irish. His stories reflect great respect for the Irish people's courage and persistence. The writer joined the Irish Guards regiment of the British Army in World War I, and perhaps his mental illness resulted from the shock he suffered during that war. Awarded the Irish Academy of Letters Award for Literature, O'Flaherty wrote fourteen novels. O'Flaherty's cousin, American filmmaker John Ford, turned his novel, The Informer, into a movie. The following O'Flaherty's works are in the library: Selected Stories; Short Stories of Liam O'Flaherty; The Informer; The Black Soul; Famine; The Assassin; and Life of Tim Healy.

Artist and writer **Jack Butler Yeats** (1871-1957), born in London August 29, was the son of painter John Butler Yeats and younger brother of poet William Butler Yeats. He is considered Ireland's most important 20th century visual artist. His early works consist of romantic landscapes and figures. Abandoning illustration, Yeats later became a Modernist. After the War of Independence, Yeats' paintings of daily Irish life and Celtic mythology aided in the emergence of nationalist spirit in the Irish arts. The first Irish painter to sell a painting for £1 million, Yeats also designed sets for Dublin's Abbey Theatre, where three of his plays were performed. In addition, he wrote novels and essays. These books on Yeats are in the library's collection: *Life in the West of Ireland*, drawn and painted by Jack Butler Yeats (rare book case); *Jack B. Yeats: A Biography* (Hilary Pyle); *Aran Islands* by J.M. Synge, drawings by Jack B.Yeats (rare book case); and *Jack B. Yeats, 1871-1957: A Centenary Exhibition*.

#### Rare Book

With the Dublin Brigade 1917-1921 by Charles Dalton, first edition, published 1929. Located in the library's rare bookcase, this is a Dalton's first-hand account of the events of the Irish War of Independence. Joining the brigade in his early teens, Dalton became part of Michael Collins' inner circle.


