
Birthday Meal

Encyclopedia of Ireland edited by Brian Lalor and kindly donated by Peter M. Callahan. This 1,200 page jewel is the perfect book to peruse on a cold winter's day, before or after a hearty meal at the UICC restaurant. Featuring 900 contributors, more than 700 illustrations and maps, the encyclopedia covers art, biography, cinema, current events, fashion, history, Irish language, literature, music, politics, religion and sports. A great resource for finding answers.

The Irish Face in America edited by Julia McNamara. Color portraits accompanied by personal accounts of Irish Americans from all walks of life, capturing the Irish-American experience and contributions.

New Childrens Books

The History of Emigration from Ireland by Katherine Prior. The book explores the reasons why the Irish emigrated, where they emigrated, their voyages across the sea, and life in their new home. A fabulous tool for young scholars curious about Irish emigration, the book also includes a timeline and glossary.

Buntús Foclóra- A Children's Irish Picture-Dictionary by Heather Amery. Although designed for the young Irish language student, adults can equally learn Irish words from the colorful and fun illustrations.

Beginner's Irish Dictionary by Helen Davies. A beautifully designed, full-color Irish dictionary containing 2,000 everyday words and phrases and a simple guide to Irish grammar.

Professor Murphy's History of Ireland: From Ancient Times to the Present Day by Duncan Crosbie. This lovely illustrated book introduces the young reader to Ireland's fascinating past, significant monuments and people. It also includes an illustrated timeline, useful facts, and website addresses to further explore Ireland's history.


