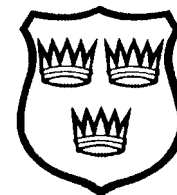

## Video Collection

## Children's Books

A new section of children's books, both in English and Irish, has been created. If you'd like to donate books on Ireland and Irish America for young readers, please contact the library. In particular, the library would like an Irish language dictionary for children, as well as books on Irish and Irish American history, culture and sports written for this age group.

## Rare Book

*Annals of the Four Masters* (Annála na gCeithre Mhaistri) or the *Annals of the Kingdom of Ireland* (Annála Ríoghachta Éireann), Volumes 1-7, 1848-1851, edited and translated by John O'Donovan. Michael O'Clery (1575-1643), a Franciscan historian from Co. Donegal, spearheaded the project of collecting and transcribing all that could be found pertaining to Irish history from antiquity to 1616. Donated by the Carmelite Monastery in Oakville, the annals include a list of Irish Kings (their successions and pedigrees), the saints' lives and genealogies, various battles and following settlements. The Irish Government generously funded the cost of rebinding the library's set of this outstanding work of Irish scholarship.

## Books by Gerry Adams

Last month in the city, Sinn Féin President Gerry Adams hosted the open forum "A United Ireland: How Do We Get There". To read more about Adams, the library recommends the following in its collection: *Free Ireland: Toward a Lasting Peace* (signed by Adams); *The Politics of Irish Freedom*; *Falls Memories: A Belfast Life*; *Before the Dawn: An Autobiography*; *Cage Eleven*; and *The Street and Other Stories*.
