

A rare account of the American rescue of six Irish Fenian prisoners from Fremantle Jail, Western Australia in 1876.

Collection Two by Frank O'Connor (1964). First edition. Short story author and Cork native O'Connor considered this to be the best he had written since his first collection of short stories published in 1953.

Austin Stack: Portrait of a Separatist by J. Anthony Gaughan (1997). First Edition and signed by author. Stack was a member of the Irish Republican Brotherhood and Sinn Féin.

Days of Fear by Frank Gallagher (1928). First edition and signed by author.

A day-to-day journal of his hunger strike in Mountjoy Jail, Dublin in 1920.




