November 3, 1917 – Conor Cruise O'Brien, diplomat, teacher, historian and writer, born in Dublin. State of Ireland, A Concise History of Ireland, Ancestral Voices: Religion and Nationalism in Ireland.

November 10, 1728 - Oliver Goldsmith, novelist, poet, playwright, born in Co. Longford. *Vicar of Wakefield, She Stoops to Conquer, Goldsmith's Poems.*

November 10, 1879 – **Padraic Pearse**, educator, writer and revolutionary, born in Dublin. **Collected Works of P.H. Pearse and The Literary Writings of Patrick Pearse: Writings in English**.

November 30, 1667 – **Jonathan Swift**, Dean of St. Patrick's Cathedral and author, born in Dublin. **The Works of Jonathan Swift**, **Gulliver's Travels**, **Jonathan Swift and Contemporary Cork**.


