

BOOKS ON IRISH AND CELTIC ARTS

Irish Hands: The Tradition of Beautiful Crafts by Sybil Connolly. Explores the world of master artisans who carry on Ireland's rich crafts tradition: pottery, glass, basket making, weaving, knitting, lace making, linen, cheese making, precious metals, beekeeping, bookbinding, and saddlery.

Mountmellick Work: Irish White Embroidery by Jane Houston-Almqvist. Traces the history and design of this unique type of embroidery, named for the place in Ireland where Quakers developed it and founded a prosperous linen and cotton spinning center. It shows examples of some fine pieces of Mountmellick work, describes and illustrates the technique and stitches, and includes work pattern sheets.

How to Draw Celtic Knotwork: A Practical Handbook by Andy Sloss. Teaches one how to draw intricate Celtic-style knot work, even beginners. Includes clear, easy and simple guides and illustrations. Also a great resource for those who knit and embroider.

Treasures of Irish Art 1500 B.C.-1500 A.D. An excellent resource describing 3,000 years of pre-historic, ancient and medieval Irish art such as illuminated manuscripts, jewelry, and religious artifacts with examples from the collections of the National Museum of Ireland, Royal Irish Academy and Trinity College, Dublin.

The Shops of Ireland by Sean Rothery. A historical study of Irish shops starting with their development from rural converted houses to city planned shops. Also discussed are their architecture, hand-painted lettering, and decorative ironwork and woodwork.

BOOKS ON IRISH HISTORY AND CULTURE

Everything Irish: The History, Literature, Art, Music, People and Places of Ireland from A-Z, edited by Lelia Ruckenstein and James A. O'Malley. An indispensable source chock full of fascinating information and captivating anecdotes written by some of the world's leading authorities on Ireland.

Portrait of Ireland by Lisa Gerard-Sharp and Tim Perry. An excellent resource whether you're planning a trip or interested in learning more about Ireland. Information is presented in a brief and concise format, accompanied by helpful maps, drawings, photos, and timelines.

Dance Music of Willie Clancy compiled by Pat Mitchell. Born in County Clare, Clancy was a renowned uilleann piper. This music was selected from Clancy's recordings and includes jigs marches, reels, flings, country and set dances.

RARE BOOK (located in Rare Book Case)

Moondyne Joe by John Boyle O'Reilly. Fenian O'Reilly (1844-1890) was sentenced to Fremantle Prison, a British penal colony in Western Australia. After escaping, he settled in Boston where he became a successful journalist and editor of the Irish-American newspaper *Boston Pilot*. O'Reilly based his novel on Moondyne Joe, one of Fremantle Prison's most famous inmates, and his own prison experience.
