



#### CHRISTMAS FOOD TRADITIONS IN IRELAND

A traditional Christmas Eve meal on the Aran Islands is a salt fish stew with grated cheese, leeks, carrots and onions. In rural County Kerry poached salt fish with creamy white sauce, small sweet cakes and bottles of stout and mineral water are part of the Christmas Eve meal. In Connemara, a traditional Christmas dinner is roast goose stuffed with potatoes, onions, sage and butter, followed with plum pudding with brandy sauce for dessert. The library has an excellent collection of Irish cookbooks for those seeking recipes of traditional Irish Christmas food and desserts.

Both videos, kindly donated by Pat Bilafer, can be viewed in the library.


#### **CHRISTMAS STORIES**

*An Irish Christmas* by John B. Keane. A collection of seventeen original tales from one of Ireland's favorite and popular storytellers. Donated by Thomas Wrin.

#### NEW BOOKS

*Irish Immigrants in the Land of Canaan: Letters and Memoirs from Colonial and Revolutionary America, 1675-1815,* written and edited by Kerby A. Miller, Arnold Schrier, Bruce D. Boling, and David N. Doyle. Irish-American immigration scholars gathered a vast assortment of documents written by the first Irish-Americans who arrived on these shores before the Great Famine. They illustrate not only early American history but also portray fascinating personal journeys and experiences, revealing the reasons why they left Ireland and the challenges and difficulties they encountered in their new homeland. Included are stories of women living on the frontier, American revolutionary soldiers, indentured servants, farmers, debtors, craftsmen, laborers, shopkeepers, clergymen, schoolmasters, and merchants.. Considered by critics a monumental work, this book is an excellent resource for those researching and curious about pre-famine Irish immigration to the U.S. Donated by Wendy King.

*The Book of Irish Lists and Trivia* by John Gleeson. Who knew that these celebrities' mothers were all born in Ireland -- Charlie Chaplin, Kevin Kline, Alfred Hitchcock, Angela Lansbury, Martin Sheen and Walt Disney. Other lists and trivia include the old names of Irish towns, the highest points in Irish counties, the 20 largest Irish islands, famous Irish people who never married, and noted Irish inventors.
