### ST. BRIGID'S DAY, FEBRUARY 1

St. Brigid's Day is a traditional Irish festival named after the fifth-century Abbess of Kildare, who founded a religious center there and is one of the three patron saints of Ireland. Throughout the ages on this day pilgrims have visited the holy wells dedicated to her, such as Brideswell, Co. Roscommon. To this day much of St. Brigid's life remains a mystery. According to legend, she converted a dying pagan to Christianity by illustrating the Redemption to him with a cross she made from straw. The St. Brigid's Cross is still made and displayed in many parts of Ireland, even hung in car windshields. The library has one in the wall display case. Stop by the library to pick up some instructions on how to make your own St. Brigid's Cross. To read more about St. Brigid, the library recommends the following books in its collection:

St. Brigid of Ireland by Alice Curtayne. Several stories about St. Brigid and her convent at Kildare. St. Brigid by Rev. J.A. Knowles, O.S.A. A collection of facts and legends about the patroness of Ireland written to honor the 100th anniversary of the order of St. Brigid.

"Saint Brighid's Day" in The Year in Ireland by Kevin Danaher. Discusses the extensive collection of customs associated with St. Brigid's Day in different places in Ireland as well as the different kinds of St. Brigid's crosses.

Crossing the Circle at the Holy Wells of Ireland by Walter and Mary Brenneman. These two researchers visited approximately 500 holy wells in Ireland, including several dedicated to St. Brigid, and wrote about their mythological and ritual origins and interpreted their symbolism. "St. Brigid's Cloak" written by Patrick Kennedy in Great Folk Tales of Old Ireland (compiled by Mary McGarry). One of the best known and loved tales about St. Brigid, written for the young reader. (Thank you to Library Volunteer, Jo Coffey, for compiling this list.)

Celebrate the event at a dinner to be held at the UICC, Saturday, April 10, which benefits the library and the Leo T. Walsh Scholarship Program and honors Kathleen Dowling McDonough. 
