



# EXPLORE IRELAND AND IRISH AMERICA AT THE PATRICK J. DOWLING LIBRARY

### HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO JAMES CONNOLLY AND JOHN MC CORMACK

James Connolly – Born June 5, 1868 in an Edinburgh slum to Irish immigrant parents, Connolly founded the Irish Socialist Republican Party and was one of seven men who signed the 1916 Proclamation of the Irish Republic. The library has a copy of this historic proclamation in the wall display case.

John McCormack –Born June 14, 1884 in Co. Westmeath, McCormack was considered the greatest lyric tenor of his time and made more than 500 recordings. You can hear him singing Irish traditional songs on the library's cassette tape, *Golden Songs: John McCormack*. Some of his early 20th century 78 rpm records can also be viewed in the library's wall display case.

### PAMPHLET COLLECTION

The library has an extraordinary collection of pamphlets, or small booklets, pertaining to various subjects and many written by witnesses to history. For arts and crafts lovers, there are pamphlets on Irish stained glass, lace, silver, Aranwear and Donegal tweed. For Irish history buffs, there is an array of pamphlets on topics ranging from coins and medals, the independence movement, labor, and socialism, as well speeches and political prisoners' writings. For example, the library has 14 early historical reprints published by the Cork Workers' Club on James Connolly, labor leader Jim Larkin, and the Republican Congress of 1934. Other pamphlets regarding Irish history in the library's collection include:

- *Ireland's Claim for Recognition as A Sovereign Independent State* 1920 speech given by Eamon de Valera to the U.S. government.
- *Ireland's Stand* Eamon de Valera's speeches between 1939 and 1945 on Ireland's neutrality during World War II. *Bernadette Devin McAliskey on the Irish Freedom Struggle* 1982 speech delivered in New York.
- Scandal of the British Internment Camps: Ordeals of 5,500 Irish Men and Women in Custody, a 1921 report written by Michael Collins that originally appeared in the Dublin Freeman's Journal.
- *The Irish Republican Congress,* by George Gilmore, signed by the author. Gilmore was a Protestant I.R.A. leader during the 1920s and 1930s.
- The American Commission on the Conditions in Ireland: An Interim Report (1921). This fascinating report contains oral and written testimonies from witnesses who describe the events and circumstances in Ireland during the last months of Britain's rule in the early 1920s.
- *Historic Case for Irish Independence* (1918) by Darrell Figgis. The author played an important role in the drafting of the Constitution of the Irish Free State.
- Labour Nationality and Religion by James Connolly, first published in 1910.
- *Journal of Prisoners on Prisons* Special Issue on Republican Prisoners of War, 1996-1997. A collection of stories, essays and poems written by those incarcerated in Long Kesh, Maghaberry Women's Prison, Portlaoise Prison, and Durhams Women's Prison.
- *The Crunch Has Come* by Frankie O'Brien. Published in 1981, this true account written by an H-Block prisoner before the Hunger Strike began in October 1980 was originally written on toilet paper and smuggled out of Long Kesh Prison, also known as the Maze.
- A United Ireland: A Working Class Demand, published in 1986 by Trade Unionists for Irish Unity and Independence, Dublin.
