

NEW BOOKS

Thank you to Sean Canniffe and the Irish Herald for their generous donation of the following books:

Irish Inspirations: Stories and Wisdom That Celebrate the Magic of the Emerald Isle edited by Angela Joshi. A collection of heartwarming stories, inspiring quotes, poems, traditional Irish sayings, toasts and proverbs celebrating everything Irish.

In Time of Civil War: The Conflict on the Irish Railways 1922-23 by Bernard Share. This day-by-day narrative from records of the time is the first account of how the Civil War affected the Irish railways, which were important lifelines. It is a human as well as economic and political chronicle. For instance, isolated communities with no railway service almost starved. The war nearly brought the Irish railways to economic disaster. A great read for those interested in both the Irish Civil War and railroads.

Dictionary of Cork Slang by Sean Beecher. The author compiled hundreds of amusing, witty and nostalgic words heard in the streets of Cork. Included are definitions, examples of the word's usage and derivation. For example, "the pawny is coming" means that the rain is coming. "I haven't a tosser" means I have no money. This dictionary is a fascinating window to the voice of Cork (San Francisco's sister city) and a fun read for those who love language and words.

Irish Travellers: Tinkers No More by Alen MacWeeney. Accepted by the Travellers (formerly called tinkers), Dublin born photographer MacWeeney spent five years traveling with them in their caravans, drinking tea and listening to their tales and songs by the evening campfire. His haunting black and white photos and essay capture a vanishing way of life. Also included is a CD of their music and stories.

Irish Superstitions by Dáithí O hÓgain. One of Ireland's leading folklorists explores country superstitions and folk beliefs. It's full of good-luck charms, spells and soothsayings, many of pagan origin interwoven with Christian belief.

De Valera in America: The Rebel President and the Making of Irish Independence by Dave Hannigan. Sunday Tribune and Irish Echo columnist Hannigan follows de Valera's controversial year long trip across the U.S. in 1919 when he solicited financial support for the Irish Republic. He explores de Valera's personal and political relationships and the costs and benefits of his risky journey. During his visit to San Francisco he attended the dedication of the statue of Robert Emmet in Golden Gate Park.
