#### BOARD MESSAGE

#### Dear Members,

The holiday season is upon us! Best wishes to all of you for the peace and joy of the season. The calendar tells us that the time between Thanksgiving and Christmas will be the longest it can possibly be. We are faced with an extended time to enjoy the renewal the holiday season often brings each year. As we enjoy the presence, the young ones look forward to the presents!

In terms of the presence, your United Irish Cultural Center is making great progress in the march toward the future. The United Irish Cultural Center (UICC) Board and the Irish Cultural Centre of California Board (ICCC) are aligned to work together for the good of the Irish community we all serve. The General Membership Meetings have a wonderfully positive tone, and there is a feeling that we are collaborating as a community to plan for the future.

Each UICC current member will receive a letter outlining the dues necessity, the fact that dues collection was voted upon (but never implemented) by the Board of Directors in 2005, and an outline of dues categories along with the dates of four informational meetings for members to get more information and ask questions in January and February.

That said, it is imperative that dues payment will be used to enhance goods and services for all members. New members, young family members and long-standing members will be very impressed with the multitude of offerings and discounts that will be available to all members after the initiation of the dues program. Look for your letter in the mail early in December. Many of you may want to consider Center membership as a holiday gift for your grown children and their families. I have made this a priority this year and it certainly saves time at the mall!

Consider bringing the whole family to the Center for some wonderful music on Saturday evenings during December. We will have music downstairs in the bar/restaurant every Saturday evening through the end of the year. 
