IRISH CULTURAL AND HISTORY

"Just thought that I would share with you the wonderful experience I had on the feast of the Epiphany. Here in Ireland it is called "Women's Christmas," and it is a day on which the women celebrate. Eileen and I invited her brother and sister-in-law to a "Little Christmas" celebration at a nearby hotel. The evening began with a "mulled wine" reception with live music. It didn't take me long to realize that Eileen's brother was the only man present at first. In total there were about 6 or 7 men attending the night's celebration. There were over 200 women! After the brief reception, we all enjoyed a delicious sit down dinner. The evening continued with dancing to a live band. Yes, the women danced together. Irish women LOVE to dance and if the men are not there or refuse to dance then the women dance with one another. This was a common practice at the dances at the United Irish Cultural Center in San Francisco. Nothing will stop an Irish woman from dancing if she wants to dance. It was so nice to celebrate for the twelve days of Christmas and not to have all mention of Christmas and the celebrations finished the day after Christmas. Decorations come down after the feast of the Epiphany. There is a beautiful tradition here in Ireland of placing a candle (or candles of some description) in the windows during the Christmas season. It is lovely while driving along the country roads to see all the windows lit up in such a glorious way."






