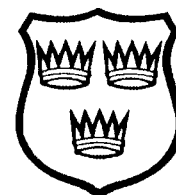

PATRICK J. DOWLING LIBRARY NEWS

GAA Collection

GAA, or 'Gaelic Athletic Association for the Preservation and Cultivation of National Pastimes' as it was originally called, primarily promotes Irish and international sporting events but also promotes cultural activities such as Irish music and dance as well as Irish language. On November 1, 1884, Michael Cusack convened the first meeting of the organization. Maurice Davin was elected President, Cusack, Wyse-Power and McKay were elected Secretaries and it was agreed that Archbishop Croke, Charles Stewart Parnell and Michael Davitt would be asked to become Patrons. From that initial, subdued first meeting grew the Association we know today.

In honor of the GAA anniversary, the library will be displaying GAA memorabilia throughout the month of November, including programs from Irish events as well as Bay Area events sponsored by the UIS, magazines, books, newspaper articles, tickets, and a great poster which is a Roll of Honor listing winners from 1887-1971. The focus of the programs is the 1970s.

Most of the memorabilia was very generously donated to the library by **David Kenneally**.

The memorabilia will be on display Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 1:30-4:30 pm except for the Thanksgiving weekend when it will be closed. For additional information about the library, including hours, please check our website: library@irishcentersf.org.

Dear Members,

32/50 is a game that combines the 32 counties of Ireland with the 50 states of America. It is a great opportunity to win some big prizes while raising funds for the United Irish Cultural Center.

There are a total of 1,600 combinations available in the game - 32 counties x 50 states. The cost of each annual membership is \$32.50, which allows members to participate in a monthly drawing for a full year.

Each member is assigned a county of Ireland and one of the states of America. There are no duplicate combinations. Each combination belongs to only one member.

A drawing is held each month at which one of the 50 states and one of the 32 counties is drawn. Each member holding that state receives \$50. The member holding the state plus the county drawn receives an additional \$500, for a total of \$550. Drawings in the months of June through March are held at the monthly UICC membership meeting. (If you attend the meeting and your name is on a combination drawn, you win an additional \$50!) The first and twelfth drawings of the year are held at a special event in May, held to thank 32/50 members for their support. The combination holders for those months (April/May) receive not \$550, but **\$3,250!**

It is possible to win more than once a year —and each member's chances only increase with the number of combinations they purchase!

The 2013/2014 membership year is now open. Mail requests to the United Irish Cultural Center, 2700 - 45th Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94116. Requests will be filed as soon as possible.

Members of the 2012/2013 Club will receive a renewal notice in the mail. The renewal period for current memberships runs through January 2013.

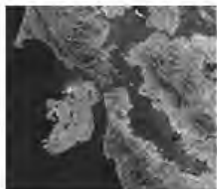
