There are a total of 1,600 combinations available in the game - 32 counties x 50 states. The cost of each annual membership is \$32.50, which allows members to participate in a monthly drawing for a full year.

Each member is assigned a county of Ireland and one of the states of America. There are no duplicate combinations. Each combination belongs to only one member.

A drawing is held each month at which one of the 50 states and one of the 32 counties is drawn. Each member holding that state receives \$50. The member holding the state plus the county drawn receives an additional \$500, for a total of \$550. Drawings in the months of June through March are held at the monthly UICC membership meeting. The UICC THANKS THE GLENS FOR THEIR GENEROUS DONATION!

Leo Cassidy & John McCormack, from the San Francisco Glens Soccer Club, in partnership with the United Irish Cultural Center, spearheaded a generous donation of funds to build an elegant display case in the entrance hallway of the UICC. This most welcome addition to the Center is a finely constructed display case built of mahogany and glass with lighting to illuminate the displays.

The Glens' very generous donation funded the building of the display cases along with a crew who worked with Martin Falvey, from the UICC's Building Committee. Leo Cassidy was very complimentary of the contributions of Martin Falvey, who brought his years of experience as a carpenter and contractor in designing and implementing the plans for the cases. Two of the cases, which will house the Glens' State trophy cups, Hall of Fame, memorabilia and photographs. The other two cases will display memorabilia from the UICC, its Clubs and the Patrick Dowling Library. The purpose of these displays is to honor the valuable contributions to the UICC of past & present volunteers, and to look to the bright future of the United Irish Cultural Center.

The Glens hope to make their home at the Center and will be celebrating their 3rd Annual Gala dinner on December 6th. They will officially unveil the cases at the Gala, which is being held at the United Irish Cultural Center and invite UICC members and friends to join in the celebration.

Collaborating with the Irish clubs and other organizations in the community-whether it is with projects like this, providing music on a Saturday night, supporting the dining room, etc., the Center can preserve its wonderful past and look to a bright future.
