Dear Members,

Best wishes for a happy and healthy New Year to all of you! As the UICC begins its 39<sup>th</sup> year as the true hub of the Irish Community in the San Francisco Bay Area, there is a primary focus on carrying through with a new slogan for our collaborative efforts for the New Year:

#### Creating the Future Through the Legacy of the Past and the Energy of the Present

Your Board of Directors has been working through plans for coordinated activities to assure the viability of our beloved Center for 2013 and for years to come. Three additional goals will be presented to the general membership at our January 24th General Membership Meeting. As a plus, the usual monthly Thursday night dinner has been moved to be on the same night as the General Membership Meeting. 


