PATRICK J. DOWLING LIBRARY NEWS

Treasurers of the Patrick J. Dowling Library Irish Fair-Official Programme



Recently a copy of the official program of the Irish Fair of 1898 was donated to the Patrick J. Dowling Library by Gloria Casey of San Mateo, CA. The program is truly a gem for anyone interested in the Irish community of San Francisco in the late 1800s and early 1900s. The Irish Fair took place at the Mechanics' Pavilion, San Francisco, August 20 through September 10, 1898. The Mechanic's Pavilion, build in 1882 and located at Grove & Larkin, could hold up to 11,000 people for fairs, concerts and the like. Along with most of the buildings in the Civic Center area, it was destroyed in the 1906 Earthquake and Fire.

Organized by the Celtic Union, the stated purpose of the Fair was to raise funds with "The Funds to be Devoted towards Building a Hall for United Irish Societies". Perhaps modeled after a similar effort in New York in 1897, the fair showcased everything Irish-history, cultural, geography, language. A complete copy of Robert Emmet's Speech from the Dock is featured in the program.

Organizers and/or sponsors of the Fair read like a Who's Who of the San Francisco Irish including Hon Mayor James D. Phelan and Mrs. O'Shaughnessy. The booths at the Fair included the Lemonade Booth-Cong Abbey, Lakes of Killarney Booth, Blarney Castle Booth, Limerick Race Track Booth as well as the Dewey Victory Booth.

Throughout the program, articles about prominent Irish people, like Sheriff Richard Whelan, are interspersed with the many ads for businesses and institutions. Some of the businesses & institutions are long gone, like Studebaker's at Market & Tenth Streets and the Olympic Club Stable. Although perhaps in a different form or at a different location, you will recognize others that are still thriving after over 100 years surviving the big earthquake and urban development -St Mary's Hospital, Santa Clara College, Carew & English, St. Ignatius College, to name a few. The people of 1898 San Francisco come alive through the articles and the pictures. We get a brief glimpse into their lives-their fashions, what they bought, where they went to school, what their social life was like. We wonder what was in store for the handsome people who look out at us from the page.

Irish Fair-Official Programme, 1898 is on display in the curio cabinet of the library. Please ask the librarian to see it. We are very grateful to Gloria Casey for her generosity in sharing the program with us-this is indeed one of the treasurers of the Patrick J. Dowling Library.




