TREASURES OF THE PATRICK J. DOWLING LIBRARY

ANNALS OF BEARA by Riobard O'Dwyer, NT Recently donated to the library by John Jones, a regular patron of the library.

The Annals of Beara, written by Riobard O'Dwyer, NT, is a three volume genealogical work on the families of the Beara peninsula from the parishes of Adrigole, Allihies, Bere Island, Castletownbere, Eyeries, and Glengariff. The Annals are considered by many to be the most important genealogical study of the O'Sullivan family and other families in the area. Written over a period of 40 years, it is a compilation of church records and stories related to the author by members of the various families. Spanning a period of over 200 years, the volumes tell the stories of three to four generations, including many who emigrated to places in the United States, such as the Bay Area and Butte, Montana, which was a popular destination for residents of Allihies. O'Dwyer, himself born in Detroit, was raised in Ardgroom, where his father owned a dance hall and was commandant of the 3rd West Cork Brigade of the IRA. A man of many talents, O'Dwyer was a well-known athlete, musician and teacher.

The volumes are an easy read and would be enjoyed by anyone interested in the families of the Beara peninsula.


