

(New Language) TO BEVOTED ON AT THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING - MAY 28, 2015

ARTICLE IV Membership

SECTION 3. CLASSIFICATION

There shall be six (6) classes of Membership in the Corporation: Charter membership, Individual membership, and Family / Couple membership. There will be three (3) types of non-voting membership: Honorary membership, Corporate membership and Associate membership.

SECTION 5. New language INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

This membership is the same as Charter membership with the exception that it cannot be transferred.

SECTION 8. CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Corporate membership shall consist of those entities, which have been incorporated under the laws of the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland, and those entities, which have been incorporated under the laws of the State of California, or any state of the United States, which are Irish or provide goods and/or services that are Irish. Such memberships shall be non-voting memberships and shall be charged an annual fee, with the amount and method of collection to be determined annually by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 9. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate Membership shall consist of those entities which are non-profit entities, and which qualify for 501 (c) (3) nonprofit status that work with and/or serve the Irish community. Such memberships shall be non-voting memberships and shall be charged an annual fee, with the amount and method of collection to be determined annually by the Board of Directors.




