The money is dedicated to the digitization of the library's microfilm and multimedia collection. Last year as you might remember, we digitized the microfilm copies of the LEADER, a historical, SF Irish newspaper. This is a great asset for local historians researching the early 1990s in SF. They can all be viewed and even better searched on the library computers. In just the last few weeks, we had a genealogist visiting from Oregon who dropped in to search our new digital records for information about his family. Just input a family name or place and up pops an article about them or not depending on your luck.


