



We welcome him back to San Francisco to the United Irish Cultural Center. A night not to be missed!



WHAT HAS BEEN HAPPENING AT THE LIBRARY THIS YEAR?

Since last St. Patrick's Day, exciting things have been happening at the Center and to the Patrick J. Dowling library. Due to generous support from the Carl Gellert and Celia Berta Gellert Foundation and individual Friends of the Library, we have moved forward in our efforts to modernize and preserve our wonderful collection. The microfilm copies of the Leader have been converted to digital images and can be read and searched on our computer. This is an asset to researchers of early 1900 San Francisco.

We are currently working on two projects: the purchase of an online cataloging system which will allow our collection to be viewed by researchers worldwide and the digitalization of additional microfilm records.

In the past year, the library has sponsored or partnered with other groups at the Center on several events including the Annual Mad Hatter Tea Party, the Roger Casement event, the August yard sale, the book event for Diane Bader's "Donegal on Fire" and the recent film screening in January. June will be an busy month at the library with the sponsorship of a Bloomsday event on June 16. Anne Carew has great plans for an even more enjoyable Mad Hatter Tea Party on June 25.
