BOARD MESSAGE

Dear Members,

August I Members Meeting. We are very grateful to those members who came out to our August I members meeting. We covered important financials and the Irish Center's positive accomplishments this year. We discussed that it would take involvement of more members to rejuvenate **YOUR Center**. The audit has confirmed that **OUR Center** operated at a substantial loss in 2018 because fewer members took advantage of the bar restaurant and banquet facilities we offered. Because members have expressed interest in the Centers daily operations, I am happy to share more details in the bulletin and at our meetings.

At the August 7th UICC Board meeting, the Board reviewed members' comments at the August I meeting and plans for **OUR Center** going forward. Ruan will be joined by local musician, Cormac Gannon.


September 15, 12:15 pm Band Concourse Golden Gate Park
